


# SAINT LUCIA SHOWCASE 2024 DESTINATION UPDATE September 2024



Saint Lucia's tourism sector has achieved significant milestones so far this year, driven by a surge in visitor arrivals and enhanced air connectivity. The island's successful hosting of ICC World Cup Cricket matches, the prominence of the Jazz & Arts Festival and attraction of Lucian Carnival, combined with improved infrastructure, has reinforced its position as a premier destination for tourism.

Saint Lucia had even more reason to celebrate this year following Julien Alfred's sprinting victories at the Paris Olympics in August. Saint Lucia is now home to the fastest woman in the world. The first Olympic medals for the island have resulted in Saint Lucia being talked about in global media and increased interest in our tourism offer. Julien's glories in Gold in 100m and Silver in 200m women's sprint are a major source of pride for Saint Lucia.

Events are a key component of Saint Lucia's marketing strategy for tourism. Our signature programme continues with many concert goers attending each of the main five days of the Jazz & Arts Festival including thousands from overseas. Lucian Carnival saw 18,000 visitors from all over the world joining in this year's festivities for the carnival period.

Sustainable and regenerative tourism continues to be integral when welcoming visitors to Saint Lucia. The SLTA website now has a dedicated hub to house news and information. <a href="https://www.stlucia.org/en\_UK/sustainability/">https://www.stlucia.org/en\_UK/sustainability/</a>

The latest overall figures (July) indicate that visitors to Saint Lucia are up on 2023 so far this year to date by 17%. As of July, we have welcomed over 274,000 stay-over visitors in the first seven months of the year. This is a 4% increase compared to 2019. Stay-Over Arrivals for July were particularly strong following a 20% increase in seats and the island's hosting of Lucian Carnival 2024. Key markets to record increases were the US (52%); UK (17%); Canada (15%) and Other World (32%). The four cruise calls during the month of July brought in over 10,500 arrivals, whilst the 264 yacht calls brought in an additional 1,700 visitors.

- The US continues to lead the markets with year to date, with 158,604 visitors January to July, 58% of visitors.
- The UK has seen steady numbers with stay-over arrivals for 2024 so far are at 50,133, up 6% on last year (Jan-July). UK holidaymakers lead the way in terms of duration of stay average at 12 nights per visit.
- Canada is almost in line with 2019 figures and up 6% on last year, benefitting from regular air access.
- The Caribbean market also experienced substantial growth, recording a 27% increase in arrivals year to date following a modest rise in seat capacity. The additional seats arose from Sunrise Airways, Caribbean Airlines, InterCaribbean, and LIAT 2020 who continue to contribute to interregional travel. A new service from Martinigue on Winair starts on November 15.
- Non-traditional markets saw a remarkable 315% increase in arrivals, driven by visitors and players attending the ICC matches from countries such as India, South Africa, Afghanistan, Australia and Sri Lanka.

As we approach the key winter season for 2024, we look ahead to the next 12 months with a preview of our latest news and events to look out for.

## **NEW DEVELOPMENTS**

Saint Lucia is earmarked to welcome just over 2000 rooms by 2025.

- Secrets St. Lucia Resort & Spa is expected to open February 2025 and will feature 351 rooms and suites along with their signature Unlimited-Luxury® amenities.
- **Hyatt** is constructing the Cas en Bas Beach Resort, April 2025
  - This will mark the debut of the **Destination by Hyatt** brand in Saint Lucia.
- A new **Courtyard Marriott** is under construction with plans afoot to open in December 2025
  - When completed, the hotel will also offer a conference facility at Pointe Seraphine, home to the island's major cruise port in the capital, Castries.
- **The LifeCo**, a new Wellness Resort in the North broke ground earlier this year. Construction is currently underway, and featuring a 523-room wellness oriented resort with a wellness theme, over-the-sea bungalows, villas, specialised clinical services, and a captivating wedding chapel. A soft opening is expected in March of 2025.
  - A family hotel and a couples hotel will also be constructed.
- Locally owned and operated Bay Gardens Resorts is also expanding its
   offerings to introduce a new wave of luxury with "Sapphire Sands Villas by Bay
   Gardens" a bespoke collection of beachfront luxury villas with 24/7 butler
   service.
- Construction at **Cabot Saint Lucia** continues
  - Located on Point Hardy, a 375-acre peninsula at the northern tip of Saint Lucia,
  - The grand opening ceremony for the 18-hole golf course took place in December 2023.
  - 12 luxury suites are set to debut in 2025, paving the way for the full construction of the residential community.
- Demolition on **Mystique and Starfish** will commence in October 2024. Construction will commence in March 2025 on the New Marriott Hotel & Residences which will add 500 rooms and residences to Saint Lucia's room stock.

#### **AWARD-WINNING DESTINATION**

Saint Lucia has been recognised as the Caribbean's Leading Honeymoon Destination and the Caribbean's Leading Adventure Tourism Destination at the 2024 World Travel Awards. This prestigious recognition marks the 15th time Saint Lucia has won the Honeymoon Destination award and the 3rd time it has been honoured as the Adventure Tourism Destination.

#### **SUSTAINABLE SAINT LUCIA**

For 2024/2025, dubbed 'the year of sustainability,' Saint Lucia is enthusiastically embracing this global movement. Our island is committed to preserving its natural beauty while promoting sustainable tourism practices such as eco-friendly resorts and conservation initiatives to support local communities and sustainable agriculture.

Central to Saint Lucia's commitment is the new Tourism Development Act, a groundbreaking piece of legislation designed to transform the tourism industry. This Act encourages greater participation and ownership by Saint Lucians through incentives for local accommodation owners and operators. It also sets high standards for certification to ensure quality benchmarks are met.

The Act also supports our comprehensive development by collecting and remitting a tourism levy, which fuels ongoing marketing and sustainability efforts.

- New Seamoss Experience in Praslin Bay with a tour and shops

- Emerald Oasis Food Tour in the community of Canaries.
- Garmaii Gift Shop & Diner in the community of Soufriere.
- Upgraded accommodations in the communities of Beausejour and Cas en Bas and the introduction of Bon Vivan, a smart accommodation in the community of Babonneau.
- Water-based activities will be unveiled in the community of Anse la Raye experiences in Dennery highlighting the story of the Mabouya valley.
- The Community Tourism Agency is also developing the Seamoss Experience in Micoud and empowering women of Canaries with a Creole Pot Concept. This will showcase local culinary traditions that includes the making of the culinary dishes with ecofriendly raw materials, provide economic opportunities, and promote

- cultural heritage through interactive cooking demonstrations and community events.
- In Chousiel, an Earth Tour will bring to life the region's rich history and
  economic value by showcasing its authentic handmade crafts. This tour will
  highlight Choiseul as the crafters paradise, offering visitors a deeper
  appreciation of the local traditions and the economic impact of these artisanal
  practices.

## **SMALL SIX SAFARI**

New for 2024/25: The 'Big Five' African safari challenge has been turned on its head as the Saint Lucia Tourism Authority launches a new nature adventure affectionately called the 'Small Six'.

The tour is led by Saint Lucian birding expert and conservationist Adams Toussaint and his team including Matthew 'Willow' Francois. Adams originally identified the list of these small indigenous creatures that can be spotted as you explore the island. Saint Lucia is known for its stunning landscape and fascinating wildlife although some are much harder to find. The Saint Lucian parrot is notoriously difficult to spot.

#### **CASTRIES STORY MAP**

The Ministry of Tourism, Investment, Creative Industries, Culture & Information and the Taiwan ICDF launched the Story Map and Smart Tourism Project in Castries this May. This technological advancement initiative allows visitors to seamlessly navigate their way around the city by scanning QR codes that will provide information on their route. This allows for visitors to indulge in the history and culture of the destination and contributes to the preservation of Saint Lucia's cultural heritage, religious and educational heritage for future generations to learn from.

This tourism initiative is also expected to attract more visitors, leading to an increase in tourism revenue, contributing to the growth and sustainability of the local economy. The project is in an advanced stage, and soon the QR codes will present video and audio guides of the city's map.

## **DIVEFEST (September 15 - 21 2024, annually)**

Saint Lucia is one of the most scenic islands in Caribbean with world-class dive sites and snorkeling just off shore. There is endless beauty beneath the surface with rainbow colour reefs and abundant marine life. The dive festival in Saint Lucia highlights the diving offering.

An underwater sculpture park is planned for 2025 along the west coast of the island. This project will incorporate three key elements: the culture, heritage, and history of Saint Lucia.

## **GLOBAL ROMANCE SUMMIT (October 3-7 2024 annually)**

'Say Yes to Saint Lucia' is a Global Romance Summit later this year, enabling agents to meet key partners, including villas, hotels and wedding planners. There will also be keynote speakers, a bridalwear fashion show and a digital media strategy workshop. The SLTA is taking a small group of UK trade to experience the summit for themselves.

## **CREOLE HERITAGE MONTH (October annually)**

October is Creole Heritage Month in Saint Lucia and an opportunity to celebrate the French Creole language and culture. On the last Sunday of October (27), the celebrations come together on Creole Day (Jounen Kwéyòl) as communities across Saint Lucia honour the French/African dialect and show its importance through music, art, Creole cultural expression, performances, and food.

## LA MARGUERITE FLOWER FESTIVAL (October 17 2024, annually)

Many Saint Lucians observe the day of Fete La Marguerite. This is the second of the two flower festivals held annually. La Marguerite members dress in the colour purple and create displays of the Marguerite flower in addition to singing their traditional songs.

## <u>ATLANTIC RALLY CRUISE (ARC - November-December 2024, annually)</u>

The 39th edition of the Atlantic Rally for Cruisers (ARC) will set sail on 24 November this year, from Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, bound for Rodney Bay in Saint Lucia, a voyage of 2,800 nautical miles. The 2024 fleet is starting to converge on the Canary Islands where they will prepare for their adventure. The 157 boats sailing this year include 48 multihulls and 15 racing yachts flying the flags of 26 nations. Top nationalities of the crews are British, American and Swedish. Ages range from 7 to 77. The 2023 ARC saw the Boat Show TV crew produce an insiders' guide to ARC to show what it's like to participate and arrive in Saint Lucia. Watch it here.

## SAINT LUCIA JAZZ AND ARTS FESTIVAL 2025 (April 30 - May 11, 2025, annually)



The Saint Lucia Jazz & Arts Festival 2024 was heralded as a sellout success featuring a lineup of renowned musicians from Saint Lucia and across the world. There were headline performances from pop rock legends Air Supply, along with Davido, Machel Montano, Samara Joy, Beres Hammond, Jon Secada and Chloe Bailey.



2025 is yet again set to attract thousands of visitors from around the world with a lineup of genres including Afro beats, jazz, rock, gospel, Soca, reggae, Zouk, pop and an array of cultural beats and exciting rhythms. ## SAINT LUCIA CARNIVAL (July 1-26 2025, annually)

#### LA ROSE FLOWER FESTIVAL (August 30, 2025 annually)

This cultural event is one of the two Flower Festivals – "La Rose" and "La Marguerite" held annually in observance of Saint Lucia's rich cultural memory, history and heritage. These two flower festivals depict a historical rivalry among communities whose members sing the virtues of their flowers. "La Rose" members pledge their allegiance to the rose by dressing in red and creating flamboyant displays made of roses.

#### **AIR ACCESS**

Direct and frequent flights from London to Saint Lucia provide year-round easy access by air. British Airways and TUI have year-round flights. British Airways offers daily, direct flights from London Gatwick whilst the weekly TUI flight (also from Gatwick) departs every Tuesday.

Virgin Atlantic returns to Saint Lucia for the winter season flying out of London Heathrow. The service starts from 28th October 2024. From this date until 28th November flights are on Mondays and Thursdays with a quick stop in Barbados before flying onto Saint Lucia. From 1st December onwards there will be direct flights on Wednesdays, Fridays and Sundays.

For the US, among the highlights of this expansion is the reintroduction of a second Saturday flight by Delta Airlines departing from Atlanta commencing in January and continuing through April 2025. Coupled with this is the second daily flight from Miami on American Airlines and the return of three flights a week from Boston on JetBlue. Starting mid-December American Airlines will also be reintroducing the non-stop service from JFK, New York, catering to the more discerning traveller.

In the Caribbean Region, from November 15, Winair will increase its services from Martinique with its ATR-42 aircraft. The new schedule includes flights to Saint Lucia on Sundays and from February 1, 2025 on Thursdays. Flights from Saint Lucia to Martinique are scheduled for Mondays and from February 1, 2025 on Wednesdays.

#### **CRUISE NEWS**

Plans to enhance and expand the island's cruise port are advancing through Global Ports Holding (GPH), the world's largest independent cruise port operator. GPH officially took over the port operations in May, branding it as Saint Lucia Cruise Port. GPH will expand the existing berth at Point Seraphine to accommodate the largest cruise ships globally, thereby increasing the port's capacity.

Plans include revamping the Vendor's Arcade and establishing a new Fishermen's Village at Bananes Bay, providing a new platform for local vendors. Significant investments will be made in upland development at Soufriere Bay, including constructing an amphitheater and dining area.

#### **EAST WINDS**


